THIS DOES NOT APPLY TO FRIENDS OR RELATIVES OF SOMEONE LIVING AT THIS ADDRESS, PEOPLE LIVING OR STAYING AT THIS ADDRESS, EMERGENCY SERVICES PERSONNEL OR EMERGENCY CONTRACTORS.

FRIENDS AND RELATIVES WILL STILL NEED TO HAVE HAD A NEGATIVE LFT ON THE DAY OF THE VISIT.

THE LIST OF PEOPLE WHO MUST SHOW A COVID PASS OR A VALID EXEMPTION TO ENTER OUR HOME WILL BE AS FOLLOWS:

- CARE STAFF VISITING OR WORKING FOR ST MARTINS IN A PERMANENT, AGENCY OR LOCUM CAPACITY, VOLUNTEERS.
- ARRANGED CONTRACTORS AND REPAIRERS.
- INSPECTORS.
- COURIERS, DELIVERY PERSONNEL, AND POSTAL STAFF.
- INTERVIEWEES.
- PROSPECTIVE RESIDENTS AND THEIR FAMILY.
- PEOPLE WITH A VALID EXEMPTION.
